Anglo-Saxon Treasure Necklace By Baroness Kaleeb the Green Eyed



- 1. Cut 22 or 20 gauge wire 12" long
- 2. Loop bead on wire 1 inch past the halfway mark.
- 3. Pass wire a second time through the hole.
- 4. Firmly twist the two wires together for about 1/2 an inch.
- 5. About 2 inches from the end of the wire, spiral twist to the center. Repeat for other side.
- 6. Take end of wire and "sew" it to wire coming out of the bead holes.
- 7. Wrap end of wire around single strand of wire until secure or out of wire.
- 8. Trim ends of wire and mash flat, so as not to snag garb.



- 1. Take a short length of wire about 6 inches with a bead threaded on it.
- 2. Twist wire together once or twice in a loop over your finger
- 3. Wrap wire in a spiral once, being careful to go the same direction with both wires
- 4. Take short end and wrap them around the wire near the bead
- 5. Trim closely



- 1. Take a short 4 inch length of wire wrap it around your finger loosely
- 2. Over lap the ends like a grape vine wreath for a twist or two or four.
- 3. Tightly wrap the ends around the loop and trim
